Volunteer Patriots Call on Georgia's Secretary of State to Follow the Law

St. Simons Island, Georgia, September 9, 2024. Georgia Election Code sets out the law and procedures for ballot access in Georgia. Georgia Code § 21-2-134 sets out the procedures by which a candidate may withdraw from the Georgia ballot. O.C.G.A. § 21-2-134 states that a candidate who wishes to withdraw must submit a signed affidavit of withdrawal with the Georgia Secretary of State.

President Joe Biden won the presidential preference primary in Georgia for the Democratic Party. President Joe Biden did **not** submit a signed affidavit of withdrawal as required by Georgia law. Legally, President Biden's name must remain on the ballot for the November election.

This morning a complaint was filed with the Secretary of State calling on the Secretary to comply with Georgia law. Joe Biden's name must legally remain on the ballot.
